BASIC CERTIFICATION PART 1

COURSE OVERVIEW

Did you know? Organizations with 20 or more regularly employed workers are required under the Occupational Health and Safety Act to have a Joint Health and Safety Committee (JHSC) with at least two certified members. Basic Certification Part 1 completed the first part of a two-part certification process.

The interactive program provides an overall knowledge of health and safety concepts that apply to all workplaces. Participants learn about legislation and standards for health and safety and, through the use of progressive learning applications, they study effective methods for recognizing, assessing and controlling workplace hazards. In addition, strategies and techniques for performing workplace inspections and assisting with accident investigations are key components of this 3-day course.

The Ministry of Labour-accredited program is available only through an approved program provider such as the IEC.
