BASIC SAFETY RECERTIFICATION (BSR)

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course applies as a follow-up to the *Basic Safety Orientation (BSO) Plus* program or as a refresher to the *Basic Safety Recertification (BSR)* program, which is revised every 3 years.

Basic Safety Recertification is designed not only to refresh the standardized safety concepts introduced in *BSO Plus*, but also to re-energize people's passion for safety and promote an incident-free culture across the Sarnia-Lambton region.

The goal of this program is to promote an incident free culture by helping learners to apply strategies for keeping themselves and peers safe. This course will emphasize workers' obligation to recognize hazards, assess tolerance for risk, and intervene in unsafe situations.

NOTE: Due to the interactive design of this course, there is a minimum enrollment requirement of 4 trainees per class.

PROGRAM CONTENT

- Refresher of rights and duties of workplace parties under the OHS Act
- Refresher of chemical, physical, biological, ergonomic, and other safety hazards
- Application of hazard mitigation tools to workplace scenarios
- Assessment of risk tolerance, including the recognition and correction of at-risk behaviours
- Identification of specific changes required to help workplaces move toward an incident free culture
