WHMIS 2015 - CBT

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course is a Computer-based Training module. It is based on the requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations, Canada's Hazardous Products Act (HPA), and the Hazardous Products Regulation (HPR).

In 2015, Canada's Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) aligned with the Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS).

GHS is a worldwide system. Its goal is to have a common set of rules for classifying hazardous products, common rules for labels, and a standard format for safety data sheets. GHS does not replace WHMIS; instead, WHMIS has been modified to incorporate GHS elements.

This course familiarizes workers with the WHMIS 2015 system and how it is used in workplaces. The purpose of WHMIS is to give all working Canadians a uniform and appropriate quantity and quality of information about hazardous materials used in the workplace. Learning about WHMIS 2015 is part of the knowledge that workers need to protect themselves and their co-workers from hazardous products.

***NOTE: This course does not replace current WHMIS 1988 training.**
